I don't like going out with friends because I get embarrassed about it and also I've had to stop driving as it's much too dangerous. I go to a special sleep clinic now and they're helping me a lot.

I've had this sleep problem since I was a child and I know a lot of people who have the same problem. It's insomnia and that means I sleep very badly. Sometimes I can't get to sleep for hours and sometimes I go to sleep OK, but I wake up in the middle of the night and then I can't get back to sleep again.
